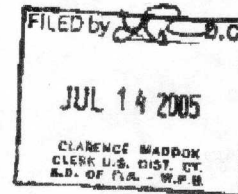

FINAL JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the court upon entry of a memorandum opinion containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, dated July 8, 2005. This court hereby enters judgment, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 58, as follows:

FINAL JUDGMENT is entered in favor of the plaintiff, Hard to Treat Diseases, Inc., and against the defendant, Dr. Ronald Shinn, in the amount of \$201,620.01 [two-hundred one-thousand six-hundred-twenty and .01 dollars] for which let execution issue.

FINAL JUDGMENT is also entered against the plaintiff, Hard To Treat Diseases, Inc., and in favor of defendants, Gerry G. Knight and Shinn Capital Group, Inc., who shall go hence without day.



(HTTD-FL) is the lawful owner of one-hundred percent (100%) of the common stock of T-19, Inc. and Hard to Treat Diseases, Inc. of Oklahoma (HTTD-OK); 2) Defendant Shinn Capital Group, Inc. is the lawful owner of Tuberein pursuant to its agreement with Dr. Chung; 3) Plaintiff HTTD-FL

has no lawful rights to Tubercin, and 4) Dr. Shinn is the lawful owner of 350 million common shares of HTTD-FL stock should be choose to exercise his right of ownership over these shares.
