

Progress on the Litigation filed by Shinn Capital Against University of Colorado, Dr. Leland Shapiro, Veterans Hospital , et. al.

Oklahoma City , Oklahoma . November 5, 2005 . Artec Inc. (Pink Sheets: ATKJ.pk). Shinn Capital reports on November 2, 2005 , the complaint regarding the use of Tubercin filed against the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center, the Denver Research Institute, the Denver Veteran's Affairs Medical Center and Dr. Leland Shapiro was reviewed by the Federal District Court in Denver . HTDS of Florida has intervened in the case and submitted itself to the Court's jurisdiction regardless of the outcome of Shinn Capital's case against the University of Colorado et. al. Also, the Court has permitted Shinn Capital discovery as to jurisdictional matters with a view to a hearing before the end of the year.

Shinn Capital also reports that they are proceeding with the Replevin action in Oklahoma . Progress reports will be issued on both cases as they develop.
